
Title: "You Can't Do This To Me", published in the June 1, 1944
issue of the "Aurora Economist"

Question: Does the copy bear proper copyright notice?

The Majority contend that a valid copyright notice is present, and they are able to do so by incorporating the date of issue of the newspaper with the name of the copyright owner, which appears in the first paragraph of the contribution, and the word "copyright" which appears elsewhere in the same paragraph.

The Minority contends that no copyright notice as provided by the law is present and that rejection should follow.
