## **ORDER**

In accordance with the indication of the Court at the *Markman* hearing held on Friday, February 11, 2005, it is

**ORDERED** that the following constructions shall apply to the contended claim terms in this matter:

"compressible seal"-a seal that is capable of being compressed in order to inhibit leakage;

"compressibly located"-disposed in a compressed condition;

"contained/containing"-have within;

"settable material"-a flowable material which inhibits leakage upon becoming a solid;

"compressed by a predetermined amount"-compressed to an amount determined in advance;

"covering"-the cylindrical part of the cap is paced over and around the top of the retaining means; and

"contact/contacting"-the direct touching of two surfaces.
