Mr. WHITEHEAD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Patents and ordered to be printed

A BILL

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That a certain design patent issued by the United States
4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent num-
5 bered 29611, is hereby renewed and extended for a period
6 of fourteen years from and after the passage of this Act,
7 with all the rights and privileges pertaining to the same,
8 being generally known as the insignia of the United Daugh-
9 ters of the Confederacy: *Provided, however,* That no per-
10 son who has manufactured the design of said patent between
11 the 8th day of November, 1905, and the date of the passage

1 of this Act shall be held liable for infringement of this
2 patent by reason of the continued manufacture and sale
3 thereof.
