Mr. SATTERFIELD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Patents

A BILL

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That a certain design patent issued by the United States
4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent num-
5 bered 29,611, which was renewed and extended for a period
6 of fourteen years by Public Law Numbered 242, Sixty-ninth
7 Congress, approved May 18, 1926, is hereby renewed and
8 extended for an additional period of fourteen years from and
9 after the passage of this Act, with all the rights and privi-
10 leges pertaining to the same, being generally known as the
11 insignia of the United Daughters of the Confederacy: *Pro-*

1 *vided, however,* That no person who has manufactured the
2 design of said patent between the 18th day of May 1940
3 and the date of the passage of this Act shall be held liable
4 for infringement of this patent by reason of the continued
5 manufacture and sale thereof.
