AN ACT

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That a certain design patent issued by the United States
- 4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent num-
- 5 bered 29,611, which was renewed and extended for a period
- 6 of fourteen years by Public Law Numbered 242, Sixty-ninth
- 7 Congress, approved May 18, 1926, is hereby renewed and
- 8 extended for an additional period of fourteen years from and
- 9 after the passage of this Act, with all the rights and privi-
- 10 leges pertaining to the same, being generally known as the
- 11 insignia of the United Daughters of the Confederacy: Pro-

- 1 vided, however, That no person who has manufactured the
- 2 design of said patent between the 18th day of May 1940
- 3 and the date of the passage of this Act shall be held liable
- 4 for infringement of this patent by reason of the continued
- 5 manufacture and sale thereof.
