A BILL

Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That (a) a certain design patent issued by the United
- 4 States Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent
- 5 numbered 29,611, which is the insignia of the United
- 6 Daughters of the Confederacy, which was renewed and
- 7 extended for a period of fourteen years by Public Law
- 8 Numbered 220, Seventy-seventh Congress, approved August
- 9 18, 1941, is hereby renewed and extended for an additional
- 10 period of fourteen years from and after the date of enact-
- 11 ment of this Act, with all the rights and privileges pertain-

- 1 ing to the same, being generally known as the insignia of the
- 2 United Daughters of the Confederacy.
- 3 (b) No person who has manufactured the design of such
- 4 patent between August 18, 1955, and the date of the
- 5 enactment of this Act shall be held liable for infringement
- 6 of such patent by reason of the continued manufacture and
- 7 sale thereof.
