Granting an extension of patent to the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That a certain design patent issued by the United States
- 4 Patent Office of date November 8, 1898, being patent
- 5 numbered 29,611, which is the insignia of the United
- 6 Daughters of the Confederacy, which was renewed and ex-
- 7 tended for a period of fourteen years by Public Law Num-
- 8 bered 213, Eighty-eighth Congress, approved December 18,
- 9 1963, is hereby renewed and extended for an additional

- 1 period of fourteen years from and after the date of enactment
- 2 of this Act, with all the rights and privileges pertaining to
- 3 the same, being generally known as the insignia of the
- 4 United Daughters of the Confederacy.
