Mr. JENKINS (for himself and Mr. EVANS of Georgia) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to make changes in judicial divisions in the Northern District of Georgia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) paragraph (1) of section 90(a) of title 28, United
4 States Code, is amended—

5 (1) by inserting after “Barrow,” the following:
6 “Cherokee,”;

7 (2) by inserting after “Dawson,” the following:
8 “Fannin,”;

9 (3) by inserting after “Forsyth,” the following:
10 “Gilmer,”; and

1 (4) by inserting after "Lumpkin," the following:
2 "Pickens,".

3 (b) Paragraph (2) of section 90(a) of title 28, United
4 States Code, is amended by striking out "Cherokee,"
5 "Fannin," "Gilmer," and "Pickens,".

6 SEC. 2. (a) This Act and the amendments made by this
7 Act shall take effect one hundred and eighty days after the
8 date of the enactment of this Act.

9 (b) Nothing in this Act shall affect the composition of
10 any grand or petit jury or preclude service of any grand or
11 petit juror summoned, empaneled, or actually serving on the
12 effective date of this Act.
