

**A BILL**

To amend the Lanham Act to improve certain provisions relating to concurrent registrations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

That section 2(d) of the Act of July 5, 1946, commonly known as the Lanham Act (*15 U.S.C. 1052(d)*), is amended by adding at the end of the first full sentence thereof the following: "Use prior to any filing date of a pending application or registration shall not be required when the owner of such application or registration consents to the grant of a concurrent registration to the applicant."
