AGREED ORDER

This matter having come before the Court on
Agreement of the parties;

it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. All exhibits introduced during the trial
will be retained during the briefing period by the respec-
tive party which introduced them, subject to inspection by
the other parties.

2. A. Within 30 days from the date of this
Order University of Illinois Foundation (Foundation), will
file in the Court its Main Brief in support of its Complaint

in the above entitled action; and Blonder-Tongue (B-T) will file in the Court its Main Brief in support of Counts I, II and III of its Counterclaim in the above entitled action.

B. Within 30 days after the filing of its Main Brief by the Foundation, B-T will file its Reply Brief to the Foundation's Main Brief; and counterclaim defendants, Foundation and JFD will respectively file their Reply Brief to the Main Brief of B-T.

C. Within 15 days after the filing of B-T's Reply Brief, the Foundation will file its Answer Brief to said Reply Brief; and B-T will file its Answer Brief to the Reply Briefs of the Foundation and JFD within 15 days after the last to be filed of said Reply Briefs.

3. Concurrent with the filing of the Answer Briefs by the Foundation, JFD and B-T pursuant to paragraph 2C above, the parties will submit to the Court Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Judgment Order relating to the issues raised by the Complaint and Counterclaim.

4. At the time of filing of the Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Judgment Order, each of the

parties will submit to the Court all of the exhibits which had been retained by them and will take whatever steps are deemed necessary to facilitate the review of the large physical exhibits by the Court.
