MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME IN WHICH
TO FILE PLAINTIFF-APPELLANT'S BRIEF

Pursuant to Rule 26(b) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, plaintiff-appellant University of Illinois Foundation respectfully moves this Court for an order enlarging by fifteen (15) days the time prescribed by the rules for the filing of plaintiff-appellant's brief. No enlargement in time for filing the appendix is sought.

As presently prescribed by the rules, appellant's brief is due on January 15, 1972, a Saturday, the time being extended to Monday, January 17, 1972 by Rule 26(a). Appellant seeks by this motion an enlargement in this period of fifteen days, to and including February 1, 1972. This is the first request for enlargement which has been made in this case.

BASIL P. MANN, being duly sworn, deposes and says:




That he has been informed by counsel that Blonder-Tongue Laboratories, Inc., defendant-appellee herein, has no objection to the enlargement of time requested by appellant.
